- Be physically active or understand the importance of physical activity for those living with Parkinson's.
- Good communication skills, public speaking skills and confidence to talk to an audience about physical activity.

- The ability to listen to and respect the views of others, and to collaborate when making decisions.
- A willingness to travel within an agreed local area to attend meetings and give talks.
